Previously, black and white renderings were standard because color printing had not been perfected and its cost was prohibitive. In our own urologic practices it became evident that the use of black and white sketches for teaching operative urology, while helpful, left too much to the surgeon's imagination. Since color photography recently has been used to demonstrate operative techniques, we climbed on the bandwagon and photographed in color many of the major operative procedures. light reflected on a trickle of blood. Even when meticulous care is taken to irrigate and clean the surgical field, the tissue sheen obscures portions of the field. Color paintings by a gifted artist are not only unique, but can be extraordinary; the vividness with which subtleties can thus be portrayed cannot be matched by photography, black and white or color.
